

## Computer Parts

## Computer Part

Motherboard

a printed circuit board containing the principal components of a computer or other device, with connectors into which other circuit boards can be slotted.

Processor

a machine that processes something.

RAM (Random Access Memory)

a type of computer memory that can be accessed randomly

Hard Drive

a high-capacity, self-contained storage device containing a read-write mechanism plus one or more hard disks, inside a sealed unit

Solid State Drive

An all-electronic storage device that is an alternative to a hard disk

Expansion Slot

a place in a computer where an expansion card can be inserted.

Network Card

contains the electronic circuitry required to communicate using a wired connection

Audio Card

peripheral device that attaches to the ISA or PCI slot on a motherboard to enable the computer to input, process, and deliver sound.

Video Card

a printed circuit board controlling output to a display screen.
